ELECTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
OF THE SANTA BARBARA AUDUBON SOCIETY

The Nominating Committee feels that the most democratic process for this first election of Directors will be to have the prospective members do the nominating and voting by mail. This will give a vote to those who cannot attend the meeting and will avoid having the election take time from the scheduled program.

1. The names of all persons who have returned cards indicating that they intend to affiliate with the Audubon Branch Society are enclosed.
2. You, as a prospective member, are invited to nominate for the Board of Directors as many persons on the list as you wish, and send your nominations before March 5 to: Mrs. L. A. Cooke Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History.
3. A ballot will be prepared including the names of all persons nominated and will be mailed to you as soon as possible.
4. You will vote by checking nine (or fewer) names on the ballot and returning it to Mrs. Cooke at the Museum before Mar. 18.
5. The nine persons with the greatest number of votes will constitute the Board of Directors. If any of these are unable or unwilling to serve the next in number of votes will replace them.
6. The results of the election will be announced at the meeting scheduled for March 22.

The Board of Directors should then have time before the May meeting to complete the new organization. This will probably include:

- a) Revision of the tentative constitution and by-laws approved February 15, for adoption at May meeting
- b) Appointment of officers and committees for 1963-64.
- c) Application to the National Audubon Society for official recognition as a branch society.
- d) Distribution of information regarding the procedure to be followed by present National Audubon Society members and by prospective new members in order to complete their affiliation with the Santa Barbara Audubon Society.
